These losses, among others, include separation, divorce, death, incarceration and foster care. Sunbeams is a 12 week program for children ages 3-5 years, who have experienced loss (such as death, divorce or separation). The program consists of activities, games and stories that are designed to help children express their feelings and move through grief.
