Who can join?

- √ Any youth in high school up until the summer after graduation.
- √ Youth in Grade 8 after April, to help prepare for the transition to high school.
- √ All youth in high school with a focus on supporting youth with intellectual disabilities. We promote inclusive environments.

Why join?

- √ To meet friends
- √ To practice and learn new skills
- √ To try different activities



What time?

Times vary based on the event. WEB events are on Wednesday evenings, Get OUT events are on Thursday evenings during the school year. Times are posted on our monthly calendar.

Who supervises the events?

Each event is supervised by Simcoe Community Services staff (a Youth Worker and Youth Worker Assistants). We also recruit and screen volunteers who assist with the programs. If a youth requires individual support we welcome the youth to come with a 1:1 worker or volunteer.



How do I join?

Registration is FREE but you MUST fill out a registration form prior to participating in any event. Registration forms are available at each event or on our website under the 'youth' link.

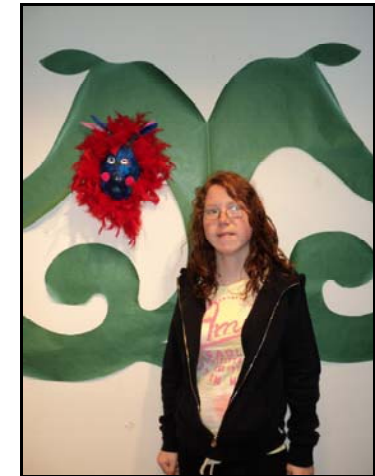
How much do events cost?

Each activity may have a fee associated with it. Fees help offset program and supply costs as well as some staffing costs. We try to keep fees affordable. Each event fee is always listed on our monthly calendar.

Activities

Activities vary from week to week. We strive to have activities that appeal to a variety of interests, and a range of abilities. Through youth input and careful planning we strive to meet the needs and interests of as many youth as possible.

Previous activities have included: bowling, night at the movies, girls/boys night, holiday parties, cooking classes, games night, night at the local Youth Centres, swimming, martial arts, information sessions, laser tag, arts and crafts, and much, much more!
